A message to All Holy Childhood Families:

As you certainly have already heard this afternoon, all Monroe County schools—including Holy Childhood—will be closed to students until further notice due to the State of Emergency called by Monroe County Executive Adam Bello based on the realization of the county's first community-acquired case of COVID-19 in a Greece Central School District employee.

School Staff has been preparing to provide distance learning and support; there will be direct communication with every school family by the first of the week; look for notices from School Program Director Jen Singer.

All Respite services are hereby cancelled.

Adult Day Services are still to occur; however, we await statewide guidance from OPWDD, and that may change. We will alert you if there is a change. **Holy Childhood will not deliver services in the community due to the State of Emergency. All services will be delivered at 100 Groton Parkway.**

Partners with Industry will continue operation; production will continue. Special Touch Bakery will continue operations at this time, although any tours and group visits are cancelled.

We will continue to provide updates as things evolve. Look for e mails, social media posts and listen for voicemail communication directly to your home.
